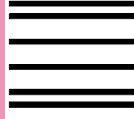
- + First tour featured five “unique” kitchens

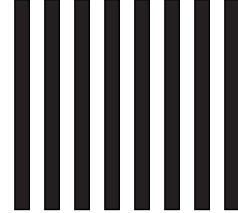

What is Cold Cap Therapy?

Cold Cap therapy aims to prevent or minimize chemotherapy-induced hair loss. It involves the use of a special set of caps, cooled to very cold temperatures and worn on the head before, during and after each chemotherapy treatment. These cold temperatures constrict the blood vessels in the scalp. This may prevent some chemotherapy drugs from reaching the hair follicles, thus preventing or reducing hair loss.
